

Q. I get an error message saying 'Requisites not met' when I try to register for a class. What exactly does that mean?

- If you try to register for a class and don't have the background that the department requires for enrollment, you will get a message about not meeting the requisites.
- As you can see in the example below, the specific course prerequisite is listed.
- Your degree audit is a good tool for checking the WSU and transfer work that is part of your record and is used for requisite checking.
- If you believe that you have the requisites to enroll in a class, consult with the department or your advisor.
